4. **Engineer Report/Gilmore & Associates, Jacob Rigg** –No agenda items. Project updates include:

Cloverleaf: to come before Council in June.

2026 Road Program: underway and is scheduled to finish up by first week of June.

Senior Center Parking Lot: July 6th tentative start date with 4-6 weeks of construction. Entire parking lot will be closed for improvements.

Library Improvements: to include painting and flooring. Applying for grant applications but considering use of Borough funds due to safety concerns.

S. Pennsylvania Ave: traffic calming approved. Next step will be to work on the grant.

PennDOT road tour: taking place this summer with Sen. Santarsiero's office.

Stockham Building: will salvage anything of significance. RDA out to bid this summer.

6. **Solicitor Report/Adam Flager** – Spoke about proposed settlement of \$49,500 regarding a personal injury matter, against the borough, involving a borough police officer. Insurance reviewed the settlement and agreed with the solicitor's office that it is a fair settlement. An Executive Session was held prior to the Council meeting discussing labor and litigation matters, and decertification of current eligibility list through civil service. Council does not have the power to decertify the list but can request civil service do such. Council can make a motion to amend and add 9F to the agenda.
